Schedule for the Seminar Examination for the Semester 1/2024 (On-Site Examination)

This announcement aims to ensure the orderly conduct of the seminar examination for graduate studies and to align with the school of engineering's policy of promoting academic knowledge, experience, and research. This is based on the resolution of the school of engineering's academic committee meeting No. 10/2021, which considered the draft of announcement regarding the requirements and details of the seminar course for graduate students and students in the coterminal degree program. Consequently, the school of engineering has authorized an official announcement detailing the requirements and specifics for the seminar course for graduate students and students in the coterminal degree program in 2021. The announcement is as follows:

Requirements for the seminar examination for the semester 1/2024 (on-site examination).

1. Students registered for the seminar course, arranged from seminar 1 to above.

2. Student submitted a seminar topic and attach documents as follows.

3. Content in the seminar.

3.1 For Master Seminar 1 (MI) and Doctoral Seminar 1 (DI) courses, students can choose 1 of 2 types:

-Introduce the research proposal and progress that is related to your thesis. Or

-Review and describe the research articles in engineering related to your thesis from journals/academic conferences that meet international standards (English). A copy of the original recommended article must be attached and submitted to the system

3.2 For Master Seminar 2 (MII), Doctoral Seminar 2 (DII), Doctoral Seminar 3 (DIII) and Doctoral Seminar 4 (DIV) and above courses, students must introduce the research proposal and progress that is related to your thesis. (This may be work that has been published or has not yet been published.)

4. Students must prepare the seminar documents in the right format and submit the article documents with the advisor's approval in time, specified by the Graduate Studies Office.

5. In the seminar examination date, students must prepare and present their articles / topic (Power point presentation, CANVA and others are allowed).

-MI and MII Take 30 minutes (20 minutes for present, 10 minutes for Q&A).

-DI and DII Take 45 minutes (30 minutes for present, 15 minutes for Q&A).

-DIII and DIV Take 60 minutes (40 minutes for present, 20 minutes for Q&A).

6. Students must get an average score of at least 60% on all committees and must attend other topics throughout the class or other seminar exam classes or experts that organized by the Graduate Studies Office at least 1 time.

The Seminar Exam Graded as follows:

-S (Satisfactory) It means pass, the score of seminar exam was an average at least 60% and attend other topics throughout the class or other seminar exam classes or experts that organized by the Graduate Studies Office at least 1 time

-U (Unsatisfactory) It means fail, the score of seminar exam was an average less than 60% or do not attend other topics. The student must re-register for that course. The grade of U recorded on the transcript
